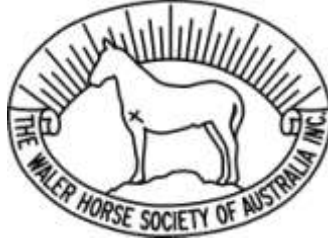

Rules and Regulations for the High Point Score Competition

1. High point score competition year operates from the 1st July to 30th June. Completed High Point Score Card's are to be returned to the Secretary by the 15th July following the competition year.
2. This competition is for financial members of the WHSA only and is restricted to pure and part bred WHSA Registered horses and/or WHSA Recorded foals (3yo and under).
3. This is a friendly in house competition primarily aimed at promoting the Waler horse breed. Any unacceptable behaviour will result in automatic removal from this competition at the discretion of the WHSA committee.
4. Any disputes, complaints or allegations of misconduct from either the High Point Score keepers (State Coordinators) or High Point Score competitors should be sent in writing to the WHSA secretary. It can then be reviewed by the WHSA Committee for appropriate action to resolve the matter.
5. Nominations for the High Point Score competition can be made at any time throughout the year. However once the nomination has been accepted no change to the horse or competitor is allowed.
6. The Person (owner or rider) whom has nominated and signed for the horse in the High Point Score competition will receive any awarded prizes.
7. Point score cards are valid, according to the dates on the card.
8. If information on the nomination forms or High Point Score cards is incorrect or missing, the points may not be counted and the forms will be returned. Point score cards must be returned to the point score keeper by the due date (as stated on the card).
9. If proof of results is requested by the HPS keepers or WHSA Secretary, the competitor must provide them. Failure to do so will result in the points for that event being invalid to use in the High Point Score competition.
10. Points for each class or event can only be counted in one category.
11. Prizes will be distributed at the discretion of the committee and / or as advertised.
12. The High Point Score database will be sent to the secretary and updates on places will feature in the newsletter.
13. Professionals will be allowed to compete in this competition. As not to allow an unfair advantage, points for different levels are the same. For example 1st place in an advanced three day Event will attract the same points as 1st place in a preliminary one day Event.
14. POINT SCORE SYSTEM
 - Participation points are only for non-place getters.
 - Points allocated per class or event.
